IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING YOUR APPLIANCE.

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should be observed, including the following:

TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK OR INJURY:

This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.

- » Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- » Unplug from electrical socket when not in use, before cleaning, maintaining, or servicing the appliance.
- » Do not immerse in water or liquid.
- » Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts of the appliance and its accessories.
- » Do not immerse. Use only on surfaces moistened by the cleaning process. Use only BISSELL® cleaning products intended for use with this machine.
- » Use only the type and amount of liquids specified under the operations section of this guide.
- » Use only on carpet moistened by the cleaning process.
- » Liquid must not be directed towards equipment containing electrical components.

- » Always connect to a properly earthed electrical socket. Do not modify earthed plug.
- » Always install float before any wet pick-up operation.
- » Plastic film can be dangerous. To avoid danger of suffocation, keep away from children.
- » Use only as described in this user guide.
- » Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- » If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water; do not attempt to operate it and have it repaired at an authorised service center.
- » Do not put any object into openings.
- » Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- » Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- » Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as petroleum, or use in areas where they may be present.
- » Do not pick up toxic material (chlorine bleach, ammonia, drain cleaner, etc.).
- » Do not use appliance in an enclosed space filled with vapours given off by oil-based paint, paint thinner, some moth-proofing substances, flammable dust, or other explosive or toxic vapours.
- » Do not pick up hard or sharp objects such as glass, nails, screws, coins, etc.
- » Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches or hot ashes.
- » Do not use without filters in place.
- » Indoor use only.
- » If the supply cable is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- » Do not run appliance over cable.
- » Do not leave appliance when plugged in.
- » Do not use with damage cable or plug.
- » Do not pull or carry by cable, use cable as a handle, close door on cable, or pull cable around sharp edges or corners.
- » Keep cable away form heated surfaces.
- » To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cable.
- » Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- » Turn OFF all controls before unplugging.
- » Always install float before any wet pick-up operation.

Before You Clean

- 1. Remove loose dirt and impediments before deep cleaning.
- 2. Pretreating (optional):
 - **2a.** Pretreating is recommended to improve cleaning effectiveness for heavily soiled carpet in high traffic areas such as entryway and hallways.
 - 2b. BISSELL® Stain Pretreat

Spray the BISSELL Stain Pretreat formula onto heavy traffic areas, soiled areas or stains. Allow to penetrate for at least 3 minutes. Clean as normal, following the instructions below.

Preparing the Machine

- 1. Release Flex Hose by twisting the hose secure latch clockwise. Unwrap flex hose completely.
- 2. Attach the Large Stain Tool or Tough Stain Tool to the hose grip until it snaps together. Make certain the tool is securely attached.
- Twist the Quick Release Cable Wrap clockwise to unwrap the power cable completely and plug into grounded outlet.

Filling the Formula & Clean Water Tank

1. Remove tank from the back of the machine by lifting up tank carry handle.

Note: This tank was designed with a flat bottom so it can be easily filled.

- 2. Unscrew the black cap and remove bottle insert.
- Fill tank with hot tap water (140° F/60° C MAX) to the water fill line. Add 60 mL of BISSELL formula to the tank.
- **4.** Replace the bottle insert in the tank and tighten the black cap. Replace the tank on the machine.

ATTENTION

Some Berber carpets have a tendency to fuzz with wear. Repeated strokes in the same area may aggravate this condition.



Make only one trip to the sink by bringing the entire portable cleaner. Fill and empty in the same trip.





Operations

Cleaning with your Spot Cleaner

- 1. Plug unit in and turn ON by pressing Power Button.
- 2. Hold cleaning tool approximately 2.5cm above soiled surface. Press spray trigger to apply cleaning solution to soiled area.
- **3.** Using the brush on the cleaning tool, gently scrub area to be cleaned.
- **4.** For thorough cleaning, spray additional solution while brush and suction are in contact with surface.
- Apply downward pressure on cleaning tool and pull it toward you. The suction will remove the dirt and cleaning solution. Continue until no more dirt can be removed.
- 6. As a final step, use "drying strokes" (by not pressing the spray trigger) to remove as much liquid/moisture as possible. Repeat this step as often as necessary.

Emptying the Dirty Water Tank

- 1. When the Dirty Water Tank reaches the **"FULL"** line on the tank it is time to empty.
- 2. Remove Dirty Water Tank and carry to a utility sink, toilet or outside (where you will dispose of the dirty water).
- **3.** To unlock the Dirty Water Tank lid, rotate handle over the back of the tank. Remove lid and pour out dirty water. Rinse out Dirty Water Tank to remove any debris.
- 4. Replace top of tank, and rotate the handle forward to lock in place on front of tank.
- **5.** Before replacing tank on machine, wipe debris from red filter.


Cleaning your Machine

- 1. Remove and rinse the tools under clean, running water. Allow tools to dry.
- 2. It is recommended that you suction clean water from a bowl to rinse out the hose. Then lift end of hose and stretch out to ensure all water is cleared from hose.
- **3.** Wrap the Flex Hose around the hose wrap and secure with latch.

Keep spray away from face. Failure to do so may result in personal injury.

IMPORTANT

Check the manufacturer's tag before cleaning upholstery. Test a small, hidden area for colourfastness. If colour is affected, do not use. If manufacturer's tag is missing or not coded, check with your furniture dealer.



For best results empty, rinse and dry tanks and tools before storing.

Maintenance & Care

Machine Care (check regularly) Cleaning Debris Filter

- 1. Remove all hair and debris from the red filter.
- **2.** Place the Dirty Water Tank back onto the machine.



To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, turn power OFF and disconnect plug from electrical outlet before performing maintenance or troubleshooting.

Troubleshooting

To reduce the risk of electric shock, turn power OFF and disconnect plug from electrical outlet before performing maintenance or troubleshooting checks.

Problem	Possible causes	Remedies
	Formula and Clean Water Tank may be empty	Refill tank
Reduced spray or no spray	Formula and Clean Water Tank may not be seated completely	Turn power OFF; Remove and reseat tank
	Pump may have lost prime	Hold end of hose below water level in tank to prime
	Tanks may not be seated properly	Pick up both tanks and reseat them so they fit snuggly on the unit
Loss of suction power	Dirty Water Tank has picked up maximum amount of dirty water and has reached full line	Empty Dirty Water Tank
	Formula and Clean Water Tank is empty	Check fluid levels in Formula and Clean Water Tank
